

REGULATIONS NOT HARMONISED AT EUROPEAN LEVEL

**ENAMEL AND ENAMELLED
OR VITRIFIED PRODUCTS**

SCOPE

'Enamel' or 'enamels' exclusively mean vitrifiable products from the fusion, vitrification or fritting of a substance made of mineral materials.

The above definitions also apply to the substance during the various stages preceding its final state.

In one or several layers, the products are intended to form a vitrified covering, melted at a [*minimum*] temperature of at least 500°C.
