SCOPE

Pieces of furniture, furniture sets, components or worked panels that make it possible to put together pieces of furniture or furniture sets, decorative panels and any other new furniture articles must be exhibited, held for the purpose of sale, put up for sale or sold in compliance with the provisions of Decree No 86-583 of 14 March 1986.
