

REGULATIONS NOT HARMONISED AT EUROPEAN LEVEL

MOBILE HEATING APPLIANCES BURNING LIQUID FUEL

SCOPE

Mobile heating appliances burning liquid fuel mean any heating appliances using liquid fuel, that do not need to be connected to a flue for smoke and fuel product waste to work.

Mobile heating appliances burning liquid fuel and the spare parts of the said appliances (list can be found in Appendix III of Decree No 92-1280) can only be manufactured, imported, held for the purpose of sale or for free distribution, put up for sale, sold, rented or handed out for free if they are manufactured, marked and labelled so as to ensure safety against intoxication, burns or fire hazards.
