

REGULATIONS NOT HARMONISED AT EUROPEAN LEVEL

OBJECTS LOOKING LIKE FIREARMS

SCOPE

The following falls within the scope of the regulation:

Supplying, putting up for sale, selling, distributing for free, or making available for a fee or for free, new or used objects looking like firearms and designed to launch rigid projectiles, when the energy emitted at the muzzle of the said objects is higher than 0.08 joules and less than, or equal to 2 joules
